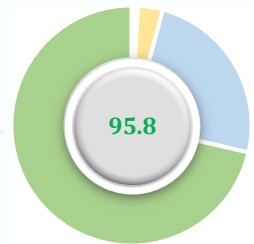

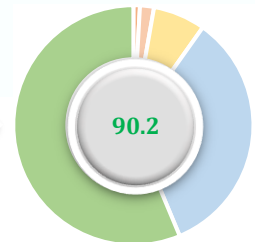

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

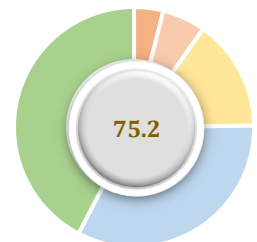

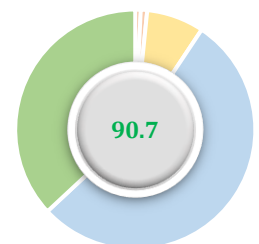

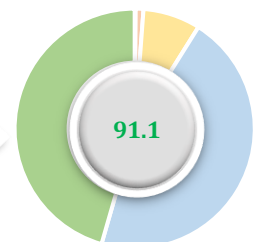

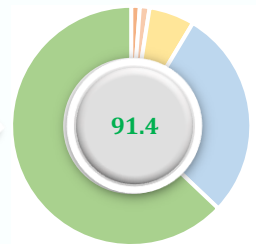

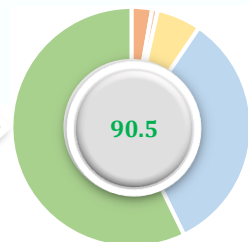

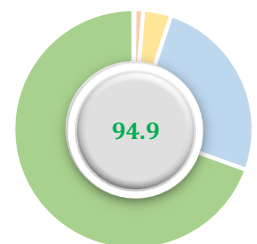

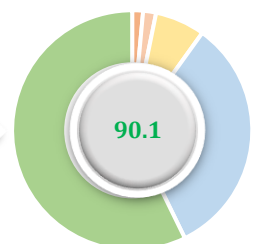

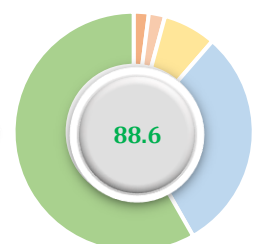

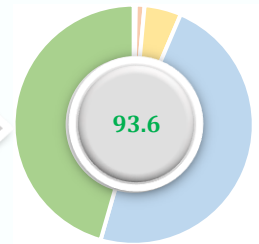

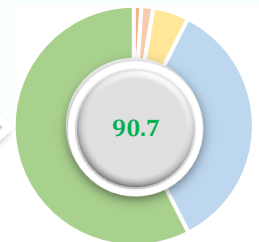

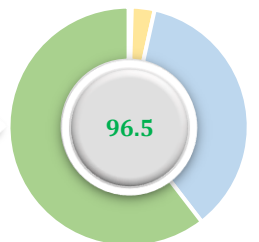

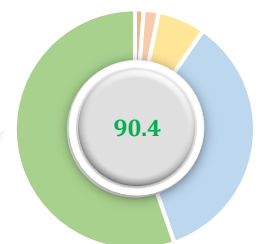

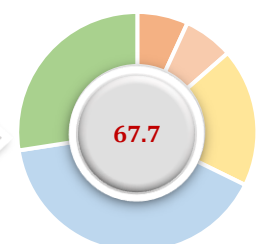

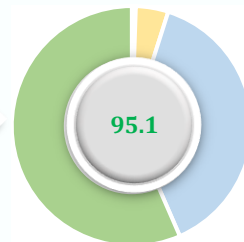

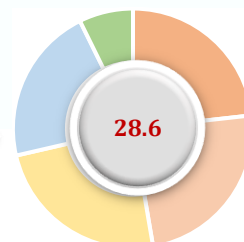

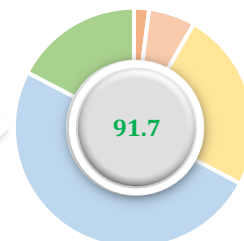

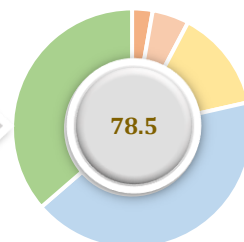

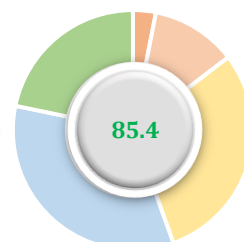

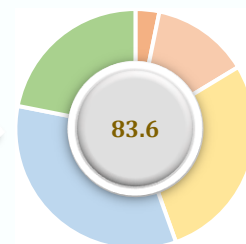

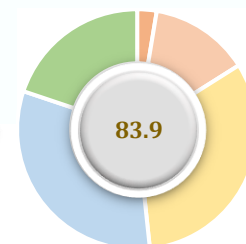

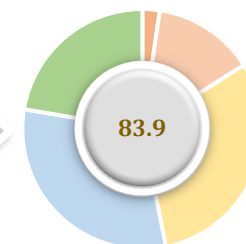

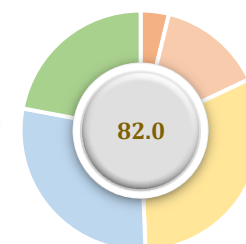

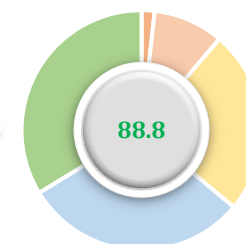

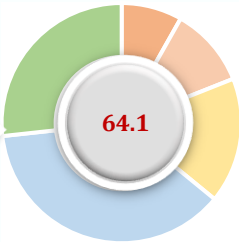

## Analysis of the responses from the survey

(No. of respondents: 284)



An overwhelming majority of students are happy with the teachers and the overall teaching process.



Largely, the students are happy with the Institute and general academic aspects.



Inculcating available and recent technologies in teaching methodology may play a critical role in overall experience of learning process by the students.



Apart from 'subject-learning', students are getting more interested in developing various other skills-sets and exposure to broader domains. Thus, various avenues for training, exchanges, conferences etc. are need of the hour.



The response to the survey regarding 'Library' facility is highly intriguing – though majority of the students acknowledge both quality and quantity of the content available in library and no major concerns regarding rules, regulations and behaviour of staff – still the footfall is strikingly low. Enhancing internet facility a definite go-to option as outlined in survey – but, that alone may not provide the full answer. More brainstorming is a necessity here.
