



Blood donation camp on 20th May, 2022- Blood donation camp was organised in College premise by NSS Unit 1 and 2 in Collaboration with Nil Ratan Sarkar Medical Hospital. Awareness Campaign in local community regarding blood donation was organised on 14thMay, 2022. Many people of our country die due to the deficiency of blood when required. Some people in our society are scared of donating blood. So to increase the awareness to donate blood and to remove fear in the people the NSS unit of Muralidhar Girls' College organised an awareness programme regarding blood donation on 14th May, 2022. Blood donation camp in collaboration with Nil Ratan Sarkar Medical Hospital was conducted successfully. 3 NSS volunteers took active participation in the awareness campaign and 34 units of blood were donated for the use of 136 patients in need.

Student volunteers participated in gender sensitization programs - like debate, panel discussion, poster making etc. in collaboration with Swayam. The special objectives of these programs are to make the students aware of gender roles, gender equality and so on.
