Department of Geography:

Geography relates human society with the surrounding environments. This subject broadens the outlook of students about the place where they survive, the air that they breathe in for survival and the water that they drink. Students will have a clear understanding of the various tectonic processes that made our earth, of the regional geographical approaches and the interconnection between people and places in different regions, the distribution of economic activities, man-environment interrelations in local and regional perspective.

Geography is a subject that bridges the social and physical sciences. Students studying geography develop transferable knowledge and skills which open up a wide range of career opportunities. After Graduation, the students can opt for jobs like schooling teaching, competitive exam like WBCS, UPSC, and Meteorological assistant in IMD. They can also get a diploma in Jute technology, Remote Sensing and GIS. Moreover, Students who have completed the course can get opportunities in broad range of public and private sector organizations. Some get direct opportunities in jobs such as environment assistant for the environment agency, researcher, resource planner and urban planner etc. This programme uses a combination of traditional classroom teaching, ICT classes, project work, computer and GIS software and GPS for various knowledge to attain the desired outcome.
