

B.A./B.SC.HONOURS IN PSYCHOLOGY: PROGRAMME SPECIFIC OUTCOMES (PSOs)

After successful completion of 3-Year: 6-Semester Honours Programme in PSYCHOLOGY a student should be able to achieve the following:

PSO1	Knowledge of Psychology and Counselling: Enable students to develop a solid research-oriented theoretical base in accordance with current developments in the fields of psychology and acquire knowledge to recognize, classify and treat many mental disorders and disabilities and to prepare them with the theoretical understanding of counselling methodologies and issues.
PSO2	Development Perspectives with emphasis on Indian Psychology: Offer the chance to diversify the body of knowledge to encompass a variety of developments, including physical, moral, social, cognitive, etc. from both Western and Indian perspectives such as Yoga, Vedanta Buddhism etc. with a positive outlook to encourage healthy interaction between the academic world and the wider world.
PSO3	Statistical Tools and Psychometric Application: Enable students to develop a critical awareness of statistics and measuring concerns in psychological research, to build skills and competencies in the design and standardization of tests for measuring psychological phenomena at individual, group and societal levels and to learn how to apply and evaluate data from psychological measurement in different contexts.
PSO4	Research Aptitude: Enable students to approach the programme in a creative, empirical, and ethical manner that blends conceptual repertory and research techniques from both quantitative and qualitative methods.
PSO5	Bio-Psycho-Social Perspectives: Familiarize students with the biological, psychological and social bases of behaviour and help them understand how the brain, mind and behaviour are related through the use of current developments in neuroscience, scientific theories, clinical examples and real-world scenarios.
PSO6	Higher Education & Employability: Equip students with the knowledge necessary for pursuing higher education and familiarize them with the fundamental requirements for any effort to acquire knowledge in preparation for a variety of employment options.
