Sanskrit is the most ancient and perfect among the great languages of the world. This language is a true symbol of the great Indian tradition and thought. All other languages in India have taken freely from Sanskrit vocabulary and their literature is permeated with Sanskrit heritage. In the last few decades, the study of Sanskrit has also emerged not only as a language but also as ancient Indian knowledge heritage. Studying Sanskrit at the undergraduate level opens up several windows of opportunity for higher studies and placement thereafter. Many institutions in India which offer Sanskrit as an undergraduate course have also begun to provide Master's degree courses for the same. Students also have the prospects of specializing in different areas such as: Vedic Studies, Vyakarana, Kavya, Nyaya, Samkhya-Yoga, Vedanta, Indian Philosophy Dharmasastra, Smritisastra, Epigraphy and Ancient Indian History, Manuscriptology, Prakrita etc. This Under Graduate programme will help our students for the study of ancient Indian religion, literature and history through Sanskrit texts.

At present there is also an increasing scope for research by obtaining various national fellowships like UGC JRF, Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship, Indira Gandhi Fellowship, Emeritus Fellowship to pursue doctoral studies. It is also possible to conduct research in Sanskrit by visiting universities abroad in Europe, Asia, Australia and America, as such pursuits have been highly encouraged there since a very long time. Apart from higher studies, other job prospects stemming from the study of Sanskrit include a career in teaching at Primary, Secondary, Higher Secondary and Higher Education Level or even appearing for competitive examinations and those for government jobs like UPSC Civil Services Examination, State Civil services, Banking, Railway, Defence services etc.
